## ***The "Least" Matter "Most": Summary (11/24/2024)***

*In case you missed it, or if you just need a refresher, here's a quick summary of what we talked about this week in the sermon:*

Pastor Jeff's sermon focuses on helping "the least of these," inspired by Matthew 25. He explains how Jesus identifies with those in need and calls His followers to serve the hungry, thirsty, sick, imprisoned, and poor. Through stories and examples, Pastor Jeff emphasizes that serving others reflects Christ's love and transforms lives. He encourages the congregation to practice generosity, adopt regular habits of serving, and not underestimate their impact. Pastor Jeff reminds everyone that small acts of kindness, done with great love, can make a big difference and fulfill Jesus' call to care for those who need help the most.
