## **Make Him Known: Summary (12/29/2024)**

*In case you missed it, or if you just need a refresher, here's a quick summary of what we talked about this week in the sermon:*

Alison's sermon focuses on John the Baptist's mission to prepare the way for Jesus and encourages believers to make Christ known through humility and testimony. Reflecting on John 1, she explains how John the Baptist pointed others to Jesus, showing that life's true purpose isn't about personal success or reputation but glorifying God. Alison challenges the congregation to prioritize God's reputation over their own by humbling themselves and allowing Jesus to be seen through their words and actions. She reminds everyone that this purpose remains constant despite life's challenges and invites reflection on how to honor Jesus in daily life.
