*In case you missed it, or if you just need a refresher, here's a quick summary of what we talked about this week in the sermon:*

Pastor Jeff's sermon emphasizes the simplicity and power of sharing Jesus with others. Drawing from John 1, he highlights how John the Baptist, Andrew, and Philip naturally pointed others to Jesus through their own experiences. Pastor Jeff urges believers not to overthink sharing their faith but to speak joyfully and humbly about Jesus, trusting in the power of the Gospel. He reminds the congregation that our purpose is to make Christ known, not to elevate ourselves, pointing us to repentance, enthusiasm, and prayer to bring the good news to others in a natural, loving way.
